#### 1. Beautify Campus with Green Initiative

4th September, 2024

The Eco Club volunteers in the college successfully planted 35 decorative plants in pots across the campus, promoting environmental awareness. Guided by Eco Club Coordinator Dr. RoopLal and Campus Beautification Nodal Officer Prof. PitamberDutt, students including Smriti Sharma, Renuka Thakur, and others participated with enthusiasm. This initiative aimed to create a greener, more beautiful campus while teaching students about gardening and floriculture. Dr. RoopLal commended the students for their efforts and emphasized the importance of ongoing environmental projects.



## **2. Exploring Waste Management Solutions**

In a bid to understand the importance of waste management, 21 Eco-Club volunteers participated in a visit to the Nagar Panchayat Chowari's Waste Segregation Plant.
